Why should I consider leaving a gift to The Clock Tower Sanctuary?

Leaving a gift in your Will is a meaningful way to continue supporting young people experiencing homelessness in Brighton and Hove long into the future. By remembering The Clock Tower Sanctuary, you'll help make sure young people always have somewhere safe to turn for practical support, understanding, and a chance to move forward.

What is a legacy gift?

A legacy gift is a donation you choose to leave in your Will. It helps us provide consistent, long-term support for young people who need a safe space and support they can rely on.

What is an in-memory donation?

An in-memory donation is a way to celebrate someone's life by supporting a cause that matters. You can give or fundraise in their name, creating a lasting tribute that helps young people facing homelessness.

We partner with [MuchLoved](#), an online platform that makes it easy to create a personal tribute page in memory of a loved one. These pages give friends and family a place to share memories, leave messages, and make donations, helping you celebrate a life while supporting young people experiencing homelessness.

Are there any benefits to leaving a legacy gift?

Leaving a legacy gift to a charity is usually exempt from Inheritance Tax. In some cases, leaving 10% or more of your estate to charity may also reduce the overall rate of Inheritance Tax applied. As everyone's circumstances are different, it's best to speak with a solicitor or financial adviser for guidance.

You can include The Clock Tower Sanctuary when you write your Will or add us to an existing Will. We've partnered with [Make a Will Online](#), which offers a simple, guided way to write or update your Will from home. If you prefer, a solicitor can also help you.

How do I include The Clock Tower Sanctuary in my Will?

To include us, your solicitor or Will-writing service will need our details.

Do I need a solicitor?

You don't have to use a solicitor, but many people find it reassuring. Our online partner, [Make a Will Online](#) which offers a simple way to write your Will from home. This is paid for by the Clock Tower Sanctuary, but you are under no obligation to leave us a gift to take

advantage of the service. You can choose to donate the cost of making the Will (£40.00 for one) to CTS when using the service.

How will my gift be used?

Your gift will help provide a safe, welcoming space for young people experiencing homelessness in Brighton. Each year we support between 130-180 young people. It will support essentials like food and showers, as well as the care, guidance and opportunities young people need to rebuild their lives.
